

## Seattle Central College Dental Hygiene Online Application Checklist

To be eligible as an applicant with Seattle Central 's Dental Hygiene program, all prerequisite courses must be completed with a minimum GPA of 2.5. All community service hours (minimum of 80 hours) and the proctored essay must be completed by January 15<sup>th</sup>. Please use this as a check list to ensure your application is complete.

1. Apply to become a student at Seattle Central College.
2. Complete the English and Math placement tests (if applicable).
3. Complete all sections of the Dental Hygiene online application:
  - a.  Upload unofficial transcripts pertaining to dental hygiene.
  - b.  Upload your Dental Hygiene transcript evaluation. Results will be obtained from you ctclink account.
  - c.  Upload 2023 Prerequisite Worksheet.
  - d.  Upload Military Discharge papers (if applicable).
  - e.  Upload WA State Dental Assisting Registration document (if applicable).
  - f.  Upload an unofficial transcript from a CODA accredited dental assisting program (if applicable).
  - g.  Upload a copy of the Dental Assisting National Board's (DANB) Certified Dental Assistant (CDA) certificate (if applicable).
4. Complete a minimum of 80 community service hours January 15<sup>th</sup>. (Community Service Verification and Recommendation form is required. Use the log form and have your supervisor/coordinator sign each session of completed hours.). Inform your supervisor that hours will be confirmed.

5. Complete proctored essay. Essays will be proctored at the Health Education Center. You will need to make an appointment by emailing [Nancy.harris@seattlecolleges.edu](mailto:Nancy.harris@seattlecolleges.edu).
6. Complete the ATDH or TEAS exam. The ATDH is only offered in Sep-Oct 2022. The TEAS is offered Sep-Dec 2022. Please check their websites for dates the testing is offered.
7. Payment must be submitted by the deadline. If paid online, the system will approve. If paid in person, please email payment receipt to [nancy.harris@seattlecolleges.edu](mailto:nancy.harris@seattlecolleges.edu).
