



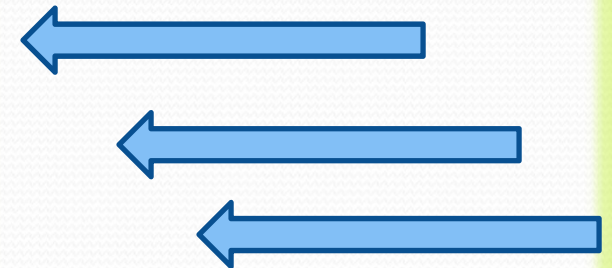

About the Placement Test

- Completion of the Placement tests (WONDERLIC) & (ALEKS) is required for those students who have not completed college level English (ENGL 098) and/or MATH 087-091 or have not had Math within the last 3 years.
- Placement / ESL-College Success testing is done on a walk-in basis; no appointment necessary.
- There is a \$15.00-\$20.00 fee per testing session (each session can include Math and/or English).
