

Estimated Cost of the Dental Assisting Program update August 2019

Approximate costs are based on Washington State resident tuition rates for the Dental Assisting program's four (4) quarters. English and Math placement exam fees, courses to meet English and Math eligibility, room and board are not included. (Seattle Central College does not have dormitories.)
