About the Placement Test

- Completion of the Placement tests (WONDERLIC & ALEKS) are required for students who have not completed college level English (ENGL& 101), MATH& 146, and/or have not had Math within the last 3 years. (See worksheet)
- Placement/ESL-College Success testing is on a walk-in basis; no appointment necessary.
- There is a \$15.00-\$20.00 fee per testing session (each session can include Math and/or English).

Repeating Prerequisite Courses

All pre-requisite courses must have a grade of <u>2.5 or above</u>. Courses may be repeated more than once. However, the most current grade will be considered in the application evaluation (Example: Took NUTR&101 and earned a 2.5 in fall 2015. Retook the course and earned a 2.3 in winter 2016. The most current grade of a 2.3 will be used in the application evaluation.)

IELTS or **TOEFL** Exam

- Students who have completed high school outside the U.S., please refer to the application for details.
- Exceptions:
 - Associate degree from a community college in U.S.
 - International students whose primary and secondary education was completed in Australia, Canada, Great Britain, Ireland, New Zealand, India, or the U.S. are exempt from this requirement. Students who were born in one of these countries but educated elsewhere, are required to satisfy the English proficiency exams.

- One set of official transcripts to the Admission's Office
 - Incoming Transcript Evaluation Request (8 weeks prior to the application deadline—October 25, 2019)
- Application fee (\$35.00)
- Completed Dental Hygiene Application (online)
 - Uploaded required forms and unofficial transcripts
 - Copy of your Dental Assisting registration if applicable
- Completed proctored essay (\$15 \$20 fee)

Upload all documents into the online application.

What's Next?

- Only those applications meeting all requested criteria will be reviewed by the Application Review Committee.
- Qualifying applicants will be invited <u>via email</u> for an interview.
- Interviews will be conducted in early February.
- Selected applicants will be notified of acceptance into SCC's Dental Hygiene Program by the beginning of April.
