## Seattle Central College Nursing Program Online Application Instructions

## Applications for the Winter 2018 Associate Degree Nursing Program will be accepted: September 1, 2017 at 9:00 AM through September 30, 2017

Admission to the program will be determined by a lottery of applicants who have completed all program admission requirements and submitted complete applications by September 30, 2017. The nursing program no longer admits students on a first-come, first-served basis. Please refer to the ADN Information Packet on the nursing program website for a complete list of admission requirements.

The online application can be completed in advance, but it cannot be paid for and submitted until the application period is open. If you have a problem paying for and submitting your application, please send an email to <u>adn.central@seattlecolleges.edu</u>.

## **Steps to Prepare Your Application:**

- 1. **Apply to Seattle Central College** and receive a student ID (SID) and PIN. If you are new to the Seattle College District, you will need to attend START orientation to activate your PIN.
- Create your application: Go to <u>Seattle Colleges District Common Online Application</u> (<u>http://www.seattlecolleges.edu/nursing/</u>) and log-in with your SID and PIN. Follow instructions to start the application and choose your program: Seattle Central College.
- 3. Fill out your Personal, Prerequisite, and Corequisite information. Courses taken within the Seattle College District may already be filled in. If not, use the "Add A Course" box and fill in Course Number, Location (College), System (Quarter/Semester), Period Taken (fall/win/spr/sum), Credits Awarded, and Grade.

Note: Some required courses are not on the "Add A Course" menu so enter them as follows:

- a. <u>BIOL&160 General Biology</u>: Enter under Anatomy and Physiology I.
- b. <u>PSYC& 100 General Psychology</u>: Enter under Lifespan Psychology.
- c. <u>Math&146 Intro to Statistics</u>: This is a required prerequisite, but the space to enter it is in the Corequisite Course Information section under "Add a Coreq Course Here".
- d. <u>Corequisites English 102/Humanities 105/VLPA Elective</u>: **Not required to apply**, but may be entered under US Cultures Global Studies category if already completed.
- e. <u>US Cultures Global Studies:</u> Not required at Seattle Central College.
- f. <u>Human Nutrition</u>: To be taken 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of nursing program unless already completed.
- 4. Upload your documents Not all items have a specific place to upload, but you can upload them anywhere and we will see them. You will not be able to "Save and Continue" until you have something uploaded in each of the areas, but you can upload multiple items in each area as needed.
  - a. <u>Criminal History Disclosure form:</u> Fill out the form in the application, print it, sign it, and upload ALL pages of the form.
  - b. <u>Unofficial transcripts from all prerequisite coursework</u>: Even if you took the courses at Central. Make sure the transcripts include your name, college name, quarter completed, and grade.
  - c. <u>Credit by Direct Transfer form (results of Transcript Evaluation)</u>: Not needed for coursework taken at Central.
  - d. <u>TEAS test results</u>: Upload Adjusted Individual Total score only the first page is needed.
  - e. <u>NAC certification</u>: Must be unexpired Washington State DOH Nursing Assistant Certification.
  - f. COLOR copy of your driver's license or other government picture ID.
- 5. Your application will now be ready to submit any time during the application period.
